Fiscal Year 2009

- 2009 – 01 **Alumni Participation at Nevada FCCLA District and State Meetings**
Nevada FCCLA encourages the participation of alumni.
Membership in National Alumni & Associates is encouraged.
Alumni who participate in state and district events must attend with a purpose in addition to socialization.
Appropriate Alumni roles include:
 Workshop presenter
 Competition Evaluator
 Chapter Chaperone
 Special Project facilitator
 Other roles can be approved by the state adviser or state meeting coordinator
Due to the difference in the ages of student delegates and alumni, alumni are not invited to participate in the dance.
State conference registration fees are to be paid by the chapter inviting the alum.
All chapter invited alumni must be pre-registered on the state conference registration Website.
The state adviser may invite alumni at her discretion.
- 2009 – 02 **Conference Fee – Conference Hotel**
Nevada FCCLA reserves the right to charge an additional fee for state conference registration, when chapter members do not stay in the conference hotel. Exemptions may apply per school district policy.
- 2009 – 03 **Conference Fee – Hotel Room Block**
Nevada FCCLA reserves the right to charge an additional fee for state conference registration when a chapter stays at the conference designated hotel but does not register through the room block.
- 2009 – 04 **Per Diem Rates - Nevada FCCLA**
Per Diem Rates for Executive Council and Board of Directors members travel will be increased to the following rates: Breakfast: \$6.50, Lunch: \$7.50 and Dinner will remain at \$14.00.
- 2009 – 05 **Per Diem Rates - Federal Rates**
The State Adviser is authorized to stay within the lowest Federal GSA Travel and Per Diem Rates when working with the Executive Council. The goal remains to stay as close to the Nevada FCCLA approved rates (listed above) as possible, however the Board of Director's recognizes that sometimes this is not possible.
- 2009 – 06 **Raffle**
Raffles will be conducted with donated items brought by chapters to The District Meetings and the State conference.
