

**CHAPTER BANNER
JUNIOR AND SENIOR DIVISIONS
TEAM EVENT**

PURPOSE:

1. To have each chapter create one large, colorful banner which shows what the FCCLA State Conference theme means to their chapter.

SPECIFICATIONS:

1. Identify the State Conference theme and interpret the theme through symbols and words.

(*The theme is generally determined by the State Executive Council by the end of October. If you'd like to know the theme before it comes to you in the conference registration packet in December, you may e-mail the state adviser kchessell@doe.nv.gov.)

2. Over-all banner is to be no larger than 5' x 3' and may be horizontal or vertical. (*Each chapter will need to provide a banner stand.)

Here is an example of a 5' x 3' banner stand made of PVC pipe.

Supplies:

2 pieces $\frac{3}{4}$ " PVC cut to 5' 3"
2 pieces $\frac{3}{4}$ " PVC cut to 3' 3"
2 90° corners $\frac{3}{4}$ " PVC
4 T's $\frac{3}{4}$ " PVC
4 end caps $\frac{3}{4}$ " PVC
4 legs $\frac{3}{4}$ " PVC cut to 10" long
2 short pieces cut to 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " - $\frac{3}{4}$ " PVC
Sandpaper
Vaseline & Glue (optional)
(may be assembled vertically)

Sand the ends of crossbars and uprights until pieces fit together well and come apart easily. Do not force pieces together if they fit too tightly. You may want to use Vaseline at the joints to make sure they come apart. You may also want to permanently glue the feet pieces together.

3. Identify your chapter and the year on the banner.
4. Let your creativity and originality soar on the design, and interpretation of the theme. (appliqué, embroidery, sewing, glue, stitch witchery, paint, etc. – but please no messy glitter.)
5. Banner must be submitted during registration.
6. Banner must be hung on its banner stand in the designated area.
7. Banner must be retrieved after 5:00 PM, but prior to the banquet on the final day of the conference.
